- a) Proposal from Cllr Harris to cut the two tables that are due to be removed down to below ground level and use soil and a form of matrix tile to repair the site.
- b) Proposal from Cllr Harris to delay installation of the astro turf goal mouths until after the visit of Scarrott's Fair at the end of August.
